



Exporting to Kuwait - New Regulation for Children Toys

The Public Authority for Industry in Kuwait (PAI) has announced that Children toys covered under the GCC technical regulation for children toys are now regulated under the KUCAS programme and therefore a certificate of conformity - Technical Inspection Reports (TIR) must be issued for such products prior accessing the Kuwait Market.

TUV Rheinland is one of the appointed Certification Body by the Public Authority for Industry (PAI), to issue the TIR for shipments of products covered under the scope of the aforementioned GSO technical regulations.

For Low Voltage Electrical products, the submission of valid Gulf Conformity (G-mark) Type Examination Certificate issued by GSO accredited Notified Bodies is also a requirement in order to have the TIR issued.

To avoid any delays or demurrages at customs, exporters are advised to request and process their TIR before the shipments leaves the country of origin.
