



Republic of the Congo Congolese Conformity Assessment Program (PCEC)

Supporting Reliable Trade and Regulatory Compliance for Exports to the Republic of the Congo

As international trade continues to expand, ensuring that imported products meet national quality and safety requirements has become essential for protecting consumers and strengthening market confidence. To support these objectives, the Congolese Agency for Standardization and Quality (ACONOQ) administers, since 2022, the Congolese Conformity Assessment Program (PCEC), a mandatory conformity assessment scheme for regulated products entering the Republic of the Congo.

Under the PCEC program, regulated products are evaluated before shipment to verify compliance with the applicable Congolese technical regulations and standards. Upon successful completion of the assessment, exporters are issued a Certificate of Conformity (CoC), an important document that demonstrates compliance and supports the customs clearance process upon arrival.

Beyond meeting regulatory obligations, the PCEC program helps businesses build confidence in their exports by reducing the likelihood of border inspections, shipment disruptions, and non-compliance issues. It also contributes to a fair-trading environment by ensuring that products placed on the Congolese market satisfy the country's established quality and safety expectations.

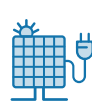

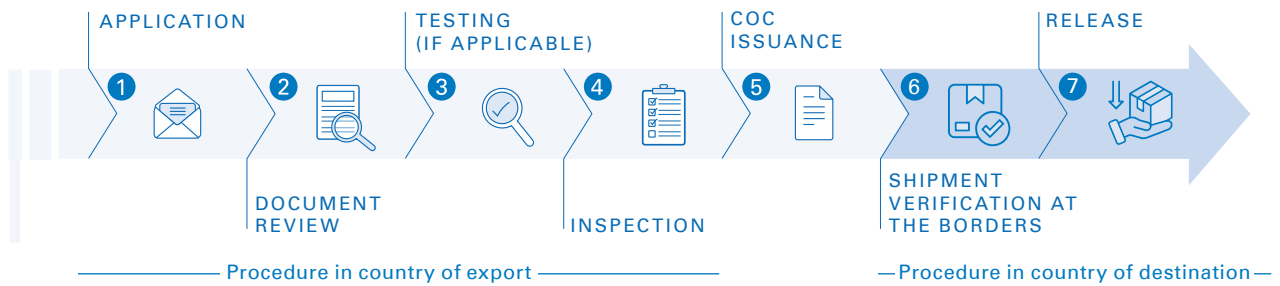

PROCESS OF PRE-EXPORT VERIFICATION OF CONFORMITY (PVOC)**DOCUMENTS**

- Application form
- Commercial shipment invoice (pro-forma is accepted to initiate the process)
- Packing list, optional
- Test reports
- Import License

CERTIFICATION ROUTES UNDER THE CONGOLESE CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (PCEC)

Depending on the exporter's profile, shipment type, and product compliance history, the PVoC program offers three routes for certification:

- **Route A:** Consignment Inspection and Testing
Open to all trade parties and product types. Requires inspection and testing of each consignment prior to shipment.
Required documents: 1. Application form. 2. Commercial / Shipment Invoice. 3. Safety Test Report(s). 4. Packing list (Optional). 5. Import License.
- **Route B:** Registration
Designed for frequent exporters of products with consistent compliance history. Products are registered for one year allowing reduced inspection frequency and a faster certification process for subsequent shipments.
Required documents for a registration application: 1. Registration application form, including the list of products intended to be registered. 2. Safety Test Report. 3. Product labels of the to-be-registered products. 4. Packing List (Optional)
Validity: One year
- **Route C:** Licensing
Intended for manufacturers with a robust Quality Management System. Products are licensed for one year, allowing streamlined shipment certification.
Required documents: 1. Licensing application form, including the list of products intended to be licensed. 2. Safety Test Reports. 3. Product labels of the to be licensed products. 4. Quality Management System Certification
Validity: One year

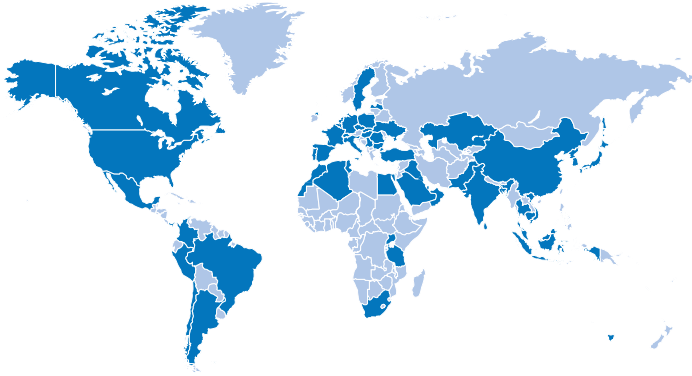

The fees specified above cover document verification, physical inspection and sampling including sealing of the containers where applicable.

The fee does not include:

- Laboratory testing
- Manufacturer licensing
- Registration fees
- Sampling of Bulk shipments
- Re-inspection fees
- Container loading supervision
- Sealing
