Adopting of Test Program for Bike Repair Stands

Working group of EK2 / AK2.1 "Bicycles" adopts the test program for bike repair stands on 21st meeting.

Actual: EK2/AK2.1 20-02:2020 Testing principle for the safety of bike repair stands

Replace: 2 PfG 1905/08.16 Bike Installation Rack

This test program specifies safety requirements for free-standing or ranking bike repair stands for bicycles and pedelecs with a maximum nominal load of 30 kg.

This test program is not applicable for products with energetic power unit(s) or other energetic components or hydraulic lifting devices.

The tests could be applied for a GS-Mark type approval.

This test principles will come into effect by 08.10.2020

Implementation category B: Implementation immediately after resolution, former certificates to be dismissed within 3 months.
