Admission requirements

Applicants should hold a bachelor or master degree or diploma completed in a minimum of 6 semesters from a university or other institution acceptable in one of the following fields:

- > Electrical Engineering
- > Physics
- Computer Science
- Information Systems
- Mathematics
- Industrial Engineering

Applicants with a non-IT related degree or a degree that includes only party of the subjects above may also be accepted (with restrictions), if work experience is sufficient.

Professional experience: Applicants should provide evidence of at least one year of professional experience.

English language skills: A good level of English will be of advantage as the language of modules 1, 2 and 6 which are relevant for the examination is English. All exams, however, will be given in German.

Verification process: In order to allow verifying your entry requirements for our masters program please send in the following documents:

- > Curriculum vitae (CV) with recent photo
- Certificate / diploma and transcript of records of the first academic degree or comparable qualification (signed copy*)
- Relevant professional certificate(s) and/or formal reference proving one year of practical experience*

^{*} May be acquired during study and can be handed in later.
